

### **NEW BENCHES ALONG OUR TRAILS**

Over the years, Councillor Bill Karsten has been very supportive of PEHRA's efforts to develop our trails and parks. He has gone to bat for our projects on many occasions, and has also made financial contributions through his district discretionary funds. His most recent contribution is the installation of 4 sturdy, well-designed benches on the Portland Lakes Greenway trail, at the Freshwater Trail end (west side of Russell Lake).

Co-incidentally, the PEHRA Board were already considering

making a request to HRM Parks for similar benches on the main trail through Birches Park. We have contacted our Councillor, and he was very receptive. Councillor Karsten is willing to fund several new benches this year, and possibly more later, and asked the PEHRA Board



to recommend some locations. These locations are all on the paved trail, in high-traffic and high-activity areas, close to play equipment, the tennis courts, and the gym equipment. Several of them have pleasant views of Morris Lake. They should make excellent additions to the park.
