If you live in Dartmouth, especially if you grew up in our neighbourhood, you need to know what is happening to our lakes. Dartmouth lakes have been a source of beauty and community for generations! Adults and kids alike have used them for swimming, boating, ice hockey, and fishing.

However, these activities cannot be enjoyed if our lakes are unsafe. For quite some time now, members of our local community have expressed concerns about dramatic negative changes in Russell and Morris lake, such as excessive weed growth and declining water quality.

SAVE OUR LAKES (CONT'D)

In the natural environment, over many thousands of years, lakes gradually change condition as land slowly erodes and deposits debris and sediment in them. Eventually, a lake may become a marsh or even mostly become infilled. In Dartmouth and Portland Estates, our impacts from changing natural conditions into land developments (homes, streets, sewers) has evidently accelerated this process to only decades. We are more frequently hearing from our neighbours and the media about lake closures, weed issues, toxic algae bloom, and invasive specifies. So what can be done to help our lakes?



In September, a town hall was organized where over 150 residents attended to express concerns over these very issues. I, as a representative of PEHRA and the Oathill Lake Conservation Society, along with others presented our concerns to the room. Participants were asked to submit their concerns and action items. The key messages were that HRM and the Province were not listening, not providing the support and resources to tackle the issues, and not acknowledging their regulatory and decision-making roles in contributing to the declining conditions of our Dartmouth lakes. It is land use control and management that has the greatest negative effects and these responsibilities are mostly those of HRM and the Province.

The objective is to start getting action and support from our elected governments. With the right support we can make a difference and take action to save our Lakes. If you want to help, PEHRA has a dedicated committee for this cause - the Morris and Russell Lakes Conservation Committee. A link to the town hall report can be provided by request. The potato sack race, shoe kicking contest, and the parent & child relay are also among the favorites every year.



NEW TRAILHEAD SIGN NEAR WOODLAWN LIBRARY

PEHRA's Trails and Parks committee has been involved in planning and constructing the trail system in our community for many years, on HRM parkland. The Portland Lakes Greenway trail is a designated municipal greenway, maintained by HRM, and is well used year-round. This Fall, PEHRA will install a trailhead information sign at a prominent location at the

central point of the greenway, on Eisener Boulevard opposite the Woodlawn Library! The sign will complement three previously installed trailhead signs at the extremities of the greenway. It will provide an informative map of the trail system and useful trail information (for example, "pedestrians have the right of way, cyclists sound warning before passing"). A PEHRA volunteer has produced the artwork at no cost, but production and installation will be sourced to a signage contractor. A grant from the HRM District Capital Fund, courtesy of Councillor Bill Karsten, will cover nearly half the cost. We anticipate that the work will be completed by early November. We hope you enjoy this new addition to our wonderful trails!
